Hunter Drive Reconstruction Project

The Contractor has finished preparing most of the yards north of Elm Creek Drive with black dirt. Sod will begin being installed Monday, November 7th. The bituminous trail south of Elm Creek Drive will be paved Wednesday, November 9th.

The Contractor will begin work on the rain garden south of Comanche Trail on Tuesday and will continue with the remaining site restoration the remainder of the week. Restoration work that is not completed by the end of this week will be completed the week of November 14th.

This is anticipated to be the last issue of Medina Minutes that will be delivered this fall. In the Spring of 2012 the Contractor will be back out on the project to finish any minor issues, correct any settlements and pave the final layer of bituminous on Hunter Drive, from Hamel Road to Medina Road. Residents will be notified in the spring prior to the bituminous being paved.

Traffic Control

Hunter Drive will continue to be closed between Hamel Road and Medina Road, except for local traffic. The contractor will maintain access to homes each night.

For the Week of November 7th, access to Comanche Trail and all homes north of Elm Creek Dr. will be from Hamel Road. Access to homes south of Elm Creek Drive will be from Medina Rd. and Elm Creek Drive depending on construction activity.

A priority will be taken to make people aware of the traffic control and the construction status via the updates to the website and information phone line. We want to work with you to keep you informed and make this project a success.

Hunter Drive will be open to traffic by Friday, November 11th. Please use caution while passing through, as workers may still be parked along the road to complete the remaining restoration work.
